## Scotts Bluff National Monument

Towering eight hundred feet above the North Platte River, Scotts Bluff has been a natural landmark for many peoples, and it served as the path marker for those on the Oregon, California, Mormon, and Pony Express Trails.

Scotts Bluff National Monument preserves 3,000 acres of unusual land formations which rise over the otherwise flat prairieland below.

Visitors can hike the Saddle Rock Trail, drive to the summit, visit the Oregon Trail Museum and Visitor Center, and even relive life on the Oregon Trail during our special Living History program on weekends during the summer.

While visiting Scotts Bluff National Monument you can drive the Historic Summit Road, hike the 1.6 mile Saddle Rock Trail to the summit, view covered wagons and see remnants of the Oregon Trail or enjoy a picnic with a spectacular view at the new picnic area near the visitor center. You can also bike the 1.2 paved path from the visitors center parking lot to the east Boundary of the monument.



The Monument is fun for adults and kids alike. Kids enjoy hiking to the summit of the bluff as well as interpretive ranger led walks. Plus, weekends in the summer, kids can learn what it was like to be a kid on the Oregon Trail during the Living History Demonstrations.

Geologically speaking, the north face of the Scotts Bluff National Monument shows the most geological history in the state of Nebraska.

The monument was named for Hiram Scott, a pioneer Rocky Mountain Fur Company clerk who died near there while on a trading expedition.

Be sure to visit the monument during this summer's PVA backyard tourist promotion. It is packed full of fun and interesting adventures here in western Nebraska. More information about the Scottsbluff National Monument can be found at <http://www.nps.gov/scbl/>, or call 436-9700.
